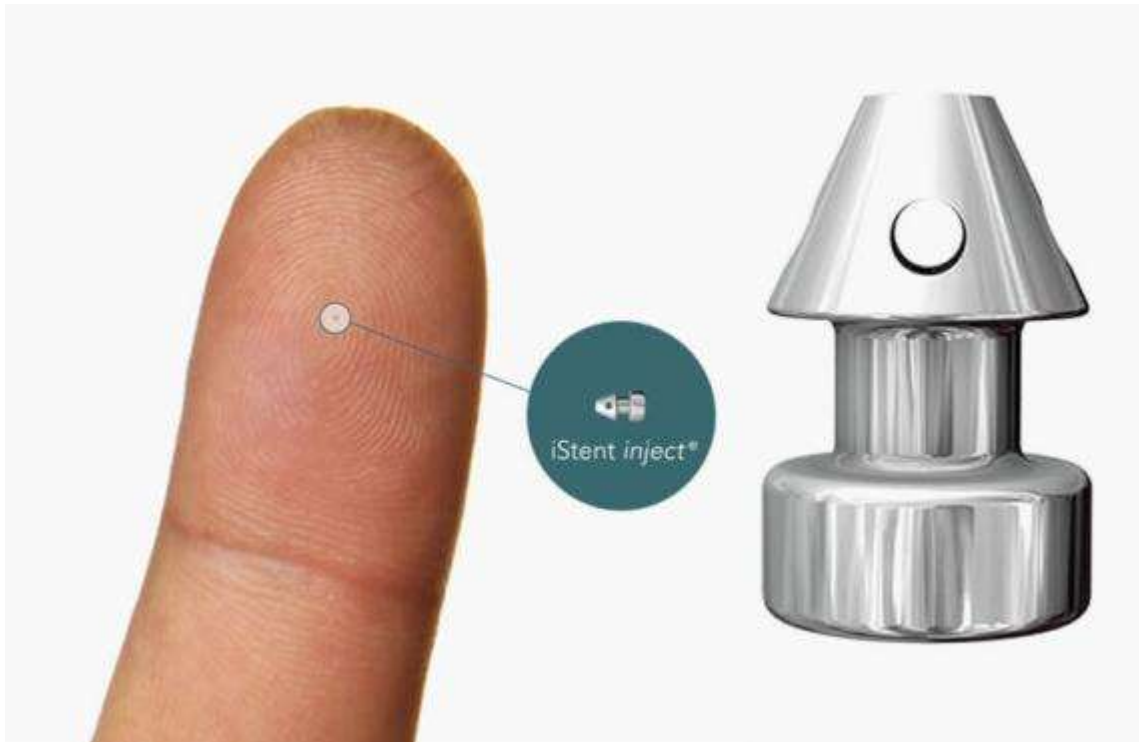




iStent® for Glaucoma

The iStent® is the world's tiniest medical device and is used to increase the eye's ability to drain fluid. It is implanted during cataract surgery. The iStent works like the stents used to prevent heart attacks and strokes. When a blood vessel gets clogged, it provides access to vessel flow. If your eye's natural drainage system becomes clogged, the iStent creates a permanent opening through the blockage and controls pressure within the eye. The iStent is inserted through a small incision of less than 2mm.
